

National Chung Hsing University Department of Applied Mathematics Professor Kuo Ching-Ping Memorial Scholarship and Assistantship Regulations

- Article 1 The Department of Applied Mathematics (hereinafter referred to as “the Department”) has created the Professor Kuo Ching-Ping Memorial Scholarships and Assistantships (hereinafter referred to as “the scholarships and assistantships”) to encourage academic excellence in students in honor of the late Professor Kuo Ching-Ping.
- Article 2 Funding for the scholarships and assistantships is provided through the Professor Kuo Ching-Ping Memorial Scholarships or alumni donations to the Department, both of which a part of the University Endowment Fund.
- Article 3 Scholarship and assistantship applications are reviewed by committee members (convened by the Department chair).
- Article 4 In principle, the scholarships and assistantships shall be awarded to three to four recipients annually, with each receiving NT\$20,000.
- Article 5 Students applying for the scholarships and assistantships shall submit the following documents to the Department office by April 15 each year:
1. An academic transcript.
 2. Recommendation letters from two or more faculty members of the Department.
 3. Proof of middle-to-low-income household status (priority is given to such applicants).
 4. An autobiography.
- Article 6 The Department chair will hand out the scholarship and assistantship awards during a public ceremony, and scholarship and assistantship recipients must submit a thank-you letter.
- Article 7 These regulations and any amendments made hereto shall take effect upon passage by the Department Affairs Meetings and approval by the University president.
