Minimum Academic Research Achievement Indices for Faculty Member
Promotion and Rank Changes

June 8, 2022—Formulated by the Department/Graduate Institute Affairs Meeting

Article 1 For faculty members of the Department of Applied Mathematics, Graduate Institute of Statistics, and Graduate Institute of Data Science and Information Computing (collectively, “the Department/Graduate Institutes”) to apply for promotions or rank changes, they must meet the required academic research achievement indices (calculated in points) as stipulated by the Department/Graduate Institutes before submitting an application for external review.

Article 2 Publications in various fields are classified into levels S, A, B, C, and D, with each publication assigned a different point value based on its academic significance, as shown in the table below:

Level	Field ranking (Note 1)	Points	
		Lead author: first or corresponding author (sole author)	Others
S	(Note 2)	30	15-24
A	$\leq 25\%$	10	5-8
B	25—50%	8	4-6.4
C	50—75%	6	3-4.8
D	$> 75\%$	4	2-3.2

(Note 1) Applicants may select the most favorable field ranking from the past five years (supporting documents must be provided).

(Note 2) Includes *Nature*, *Science*, *Cell*, *Annals of Mathematics*, and other journals recognized by the Faculty Evaluation Committee of the Department/Graduate Institutes.

Article 3 The minimum points required for promotion applications are as follows: (promotion to professorship) at least 25 points; (promotion to associate or assistant professorship) at least 20 points.

Article 4 In principle, only SCI- and SSCI-indexed journal papers may be used as reference publications.

Article 5 Applicants may provide evidence for the classification of their publications, with the final point allocations to be reviewed by the Faculty Evaluation Committee of the Department/Graduate Institutes.
