Scholarship Review Regulations of the Department of Applied Mathematics

January 9, 2019 Formulated by the Department Affairs Meeting

October 13, 2021 Amended by the Department Affairs Meeting

- Article 1 Article 1 The Department of Applied Mathematics (hereinafter referred to as “the Department”) has formulated the *Scholarship Review Regulations of the Department of Applied Mathematics* (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) in accordance with the *College of Science Scholarship Regulations* to recognize students demonstrating academic and personal excellence.
- Article 2 Only students currently enrolled in the Department’s undergraduate and graduate programs are eligible.
- Article 3 Scholarship applications are reviewed by a committee (convened by the Department chair), which comprises academic committee members.
- Article 4 Eligibility and award amounts:
- (1) NCHU CoS Outstanding Academics Award: 1. Undergraduate students of the Department with outstanding academic performance in the previous academic year; 2. The students are not on study extensions; exceptions can be made for those extending their studies due to taking a double major; 3. The students demonstrate good conduct and have no disciplinary records; 4. The students are enrolled in courses worth at least 15 credits in the current year; exceptions can be made for students in their final year, who may enroll in courses worth at least 9 credits; 5. Up to 9 applicants are awarded, each receiving NT\$3,000 or more.
 - (2) NCHU CoS Excellent Academics Award: 1. Undergraduate students of the Department who ranked in the top 20% in mathematics-related courses in the previous academic year; 2. The students are not on study extensions; exceptions can be made for those extending their studies due to taking a double major; 3. The students demonstrate good conduct and have no disciplinary records; 4. The students are enrolled in courses worth at least 15 credits in the current year; exceptions can be made for students in their final year, who may enroll in courses worth at least 9 credits; 5. Up to 9

applicants are awarded, each receiving NT\$1,000 or more.

- (3) Students who bring recognition to the Department through national or international competitions or events, or demonstrate exemplary services to the Department are awarded between NT\$3,000 and NT\$30,000, along with a certificate of recognition.

The number of recipients and award amounts may be adjusted annually based on the total budget.

Article 5 Applications are accepted once per academic year, with deadlines announced separately. Students must submit their applications to the Department, and approved applications shall be forwarded to the College of Science.

Article 6 The list of approved recipients shall be announced publicly, and certificates of recognition shall be awarded by the dean of the College of Science later. Scholarship funds are transferred directly to recipients' accounts following the applicable administrative processing by the College Office.

Article 7 The Regulations and any amendments made hereto shall take effect upon passage by the Department Affairs Meetings and approval by the University president.
