Required Courses for Master's Students

March 20, 2003 Formulated by the Department Affairs Meeting June 8, 2022 Amendments (Articles 1, 2, and 4) passed by the Department Affairs Meeting December 27, 2023 Amendments (Articles 1-4) passed by the Department Affairs Meeting

- Article 1 Required course for the Department of Applied Mathematics ("the Department") master's program: <u>Analysis</u>.
- Article 2 Students in the Department's program must earn at least 18 credits from program courses.
- Article 3 The minimum number of credits required to graduate from the program is 24 credits (excluding credits earned from <u>master's</u> theses, seminars, literature studies and discussions, independent studies, and research seminars). Students' advisors shall help them with course selection.
- Article 4 Credit requirements for master's students each semester:

 Starting from the 1993 academic year, first-year master's students must take courses worth a total of at least 9 credits per semester. (Effective September 23, 1993) This requirement may be waived in special cases upon approval by the Academic Committee.
- Article 5 Students must attend at least a combined four semesters of Keynote Speech (I) and Keynote Speech (II). Students graduating one semester or one academic year early may be exempt from this requirement.
