Regulations Governing Graduate Students' Direct Pursuit of Doctoral Programs

(Approved by the Department Affairs Meeting on June 10, 2004)

- Article 1 Applicants must meet the qualifications set by the Ministry of Education and the University (e.g., applicants must have a first-year overall average of 85 or above and rank within the top third of their respective classes).
- Article 2 Applicants must participate in an oral examination for the doctoral program division that they applied to, and whether they have passed the examinations will be determined by the oral examination committee of the respective division.
- Article 3 Applicants' oral examination results and academic records will be reviewed by Academic Committee members. Approval requires a majority vote of the committee members present and subsequent approval by the Department Affairs Meeting; the application will then be submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs and the Ministry of Education for finalization.

Note: First-year graduate students with an overall average of 85 or above and who rank within the top third of their division in the first semester may apply to the graduate institute director by April 30 each year.
